Items of note: a deposit of \$1,047.50 was made from concession sales at the district semi-final boys basketball tournament game we hosted in March and a deposit of \$120.00 was from Yolish Yogurt from the Davidson/Darby basketball game. Expenses include a \$100 donation to the B+ campaign (Joe Kenny) and a \$50 donation to the Ohio Wildlife Center (in memory of Kyle Miller). The Ernst Fund now has a balance of \$3,505.55.

It was suggested that coaches and the athletic department should improve the process of getting patches earned to our student athletes more quickly. Patches are often received up to a year after earning or even after a student has graduated.

## **VI. President's Report –presented by Laura Barnett**

### Concessions:

Wildcat Premiere Track Meet: The gross receipts from this year were \$3,236.78 (in 2013, they were \$3,891.47 and in 2012, they were \$3,309.21 and in 2011, they were \$3,375.00). We provided 160 coaches meals at cost (\$240 total), which is not counted in the gross receipts. The track team paid for these meals. Pulp offered smoothies. And we had portable restrooms paid for by the district. A thank you card to Archie Armentrout/Grounds was circulated for signatures.

Middle School Track Meet: May 1. Football and Cheerleading have been assigned to provide concession volunteers. Each team should provide 5 adults and some student volunteers.

A track meet on April 17 was just added to the schedule. Pam asked if anyone could assist her in covering this event. Laura, Lou, and Christine volunteered.

Laura shared a PowerPoint presentation on concessions. Team reps need to find volunteers to cover events assigned to their team. Providing concessions at athletic events is a service we provide. Tina will e-mail the presentation to the booster distribution list.

Scholarships: There were 28 eligible applicants this year. The committee will be interviewing 14 student athletes tomorrow and selecting up to 8 students to receive the scholarships. The class of 2014 is very strong and the selection process will be especially difficult this year.

## **VIII. New Business**

Laura would like us to consider hosting a "Meet the Teams Night" in the fall (and perhaps expanding for other seasons, as well). We could have food trucks for tailgating, charge admission, introduce fall athletic teams, have scrimmages, and even some fun contests. It would be a way to involve the community, similar to Wildcat Excellent Adventure.
